

AIRPORT EXPRESS – Bus from Prague airport to the Main railway station



- *The bus line AIRPORT EXPRESS (AE) connects Prague Airport with Prague Main Railway station (Praha Hlavni Nadrazi)- metro line C and connection to SC, EC, IC and EN trains - **35 min***

Tickets valid in the AIRPORT EXPRESS bus line

Any of the following tickets are valid:

- Any Czech railway ticket having ticket issued to / from the station Praha letiště (NAD) (Prague airport).
- International ticket issued abroad: European east pass, Austria & Czech rail pass and Czech flexipass.
- Buying the ticket directly from the driver. The cost is 50 CZK (children 6 – 15 years 25 CZK). Between Dejvicka and airport only 30 CZK.

Luggages are **free of charge**.

Attention: usual Prague public transport tickets cannot be used in the AE bus line.

The bus line AE operates:

- daily from 5 a.m. till 10 p.m.
- in a regular interval of 30 minutes

The buses used are solely **low-floor vehicles** offering easy entry and sufficient space for luggage.

Stops of the AIRPORT EXPRESS bus line:

- Prague Main Railway station (Praha Hlavni Nadrazi)
The stop is placed in *Wilsonova* street. The way to the stop is guided with signs.
- Masarykovo Nadrazi railway station

The stop is placed in front of the station. The bus stops only on the way **from the airport.**

- Dejvická (metro station)

The stop is placed in the public transport terminal by the exit of the metro station.

- Prague airport Ruzyně – Terminal Sever 1 (North 1):

The stop is placed in the public transport terminal in front of the terminal building of the Praha-Ruzyně Terminal Sever 1 (North 1).

- Prague airport Ruzyně – Terminal Sever 2 (North 2):

The stop is placed in the public transport terminal in front of the terminal building of the Praha-Ruzyně Terminal Sever 2 (North 2).
